- involve them into evaluating our methods according to the hand model
- make them interactive
- give them a taste of the camp's 10 intensive days within 2 hours
- show the complexity of the features in our camp
- explain how the camps build on each other from age 7 to adulthood
- discuss the importance of all of our programs being organized by volunteers
- give as many ideas to the participants as we can
- use the hand model as a returning centre point in our discussions
